Students will realize the price Jesus paid for their sins and understand God's plan of salvation.

Students will see that Jesus has strong, human feelings, just as they do.

18 Does He have a sense of humor? Jean

Luke 6:20-26, 41-42; 7:31-35; 12:16-21

Students will see that while Jesus isn't a comedian, He did show a sense of humor when He was on earth and they can feel comfortable with Jesus because He understands the value of laughter and fun as well as seriousness.

Students will see that Jesus was a loyal, caring, down-to-earth friend to his disciples.

Students will see that Jesus took real risks and suffered real pain in standing for the truth and sacrificing His life for us.

Students will see that Jesus felt and demonstrated real, personal love when He was on earth.
